REVEREND RICHARD PRICE 1742

Reverend Richard Price was born at Ishmael in Carmarthen in 1704. He gained his B.A. from Oxford in 1726 and was made a deacon at Oxford in 1731 and a priest at Peterborough in 1733.

He served as a curate at Hambleton in Rutland before becoming vicar at Cotterstock in 1742.

Reverend Richard Price was the Vicar of St Andrew's for 29 years and during that time had four children. Sadly they all died in infancy and are buried in the churchyard although there is no record of where the graves are.

- Katherine was born in 1753 and died in 1754 before her first birthday
- Benjamin was born in 1754 and died before his first birthday
- Jane was born in 1757 and she also died that same year.

Richard Price died in 1771 whilst still Vicar of Cotterstock and his wife died in 1779.
