REVEREND ALEXANDER MACDONALD 1831



Reverend Alexander MacDonald was Vicar of St Andrew's for twenty-two years and has an impressive memorial in the tower. He died in post in June 1852 aged 53 years.



He was the first vicar to live in the newly extended Vicarage.

The vicarage was refurbished by James Richardson of Stamford in the spring of 1831.
