## Reverend Samuel Ward and Charity Peach



Reverend Samuel Ward was the vicar at St Andrew's for sixteen years.

On the 26 August 1788 he married Charity Peach, who was a local girl. Reverend Sir George Booth who lived at Cotterstock Hall officiated at their wedding. Their wedding is recorded in the wedding register and Charity made a mark where a signature was required.

Reverend Samuel Ward was only married for two years, he died in 1790 and according to the burial register in St Andrew's he is buried "somewhere in the churchyard".
