

William Carter Henson and Eliza Garner

On the 14th March 1875 William Carter Henson, a groom, married Eliza Garner. On the 17th June 1876 they had a daughter, Elizabeth Gertrude, who was baptised in St Andrew's and then a son, William Garner, in 1877. Sadly William died aged just 9 months and we know from the burial records that he is buried in St Andrew's churchyard but we don't know where.

The 1881 Census shows us that they had another child, Thomas Edward, and Eliza's mother Mary, a widow, living with them too. William's profession is listed as a cottager and Eliza's as a cottager's wife. A cottager was an agricultural labourer living in a cottage provided by the farmer.
